**Starbucks Prices**

Some one told me that Starbucks coffee cost too much. Their full price for a brewed copy of coffee is only \$1.50. Their fancy coffees are a little more. I don't drink them so I am not sure of the prices.



The way I figure it my cup of morning coffee only cost me about 85¢. That is 43% less than full price. Here is how I figure it.

I use my reward points from my Visa or Discover credit cards to buy the Starbucks gift cards. I register these cards at Starbucks.com to get discounts.

Discover card lets you redeemed 45 of your reward

points for a \$50.00 gift card. That is a 10% discount.

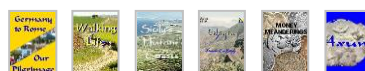
If you register your gift card at Starbucks and use it they give you a free refill. That is worth 50¢ or I think of it as a free cup at \$1.50. I figure that I get a refill ever five cups so it averages 20% a discount.

Wait, I forget to tell you I bring my own cup. That is 10¢ off another 7.5% discount. I just wipe it dry and rinse it out when I get home and put it back in the car on my next trip out.

Let's see how I get another free cup. Oh yes, if you use the gift card to buy your drink they send you a card in the mail for a free drink every 15 you buy with the card. With this free drink they have let me by a banana strawberry smoothly. They sell for \$3.95. For this I am only saying I get another \$1.50 cup of coffee free. I wonder if I could get a free refill too. No mater one out of fifteen free is another 7.5% discount.

Let me put this all together so you can see how I figure.

I moved 5 big items to the tree bank next to the street. I mad up 3 big signs that only said; "FREE to a good home."

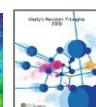
After I came in the house I looked out and saw one of them was gone all ready and an hour later another.

First the battery was still dead so I jumped it with my heavy duty charger to make sure it would start. No luck so I figured it would just need a new battery.

I pulled one of the batteries off the solar/windmill array to jump it. Those batteries are big enough to start this little four cylinder engine. It started right up!

I left it run while I priced the battery on the internet. At Farm & Fleet they start at around \$52.00. Even the higher priced batteries

were only \$75.00. That is a small price to pay.

When I came out to see how it was running, and running great it does. I notice that it was pumping gasoline all over the driveway from somewhere under the middle.

I shut down the engine and waited a while then look to see where it might have been coming from. With the engine off it didn't leak. I could see the leak but there was gas all over the top and side of the gas tank.

It was leaking too bad to drive it somewhere. I am guessing that it could cost one to two hundred to get it fixed.

I came in to figure the value if I trade it in. It looks I could get \$800 if it was in very good shape which it is not. So maybe \$500 if I am lucky. I can donate it and write of \$500 as a tax deduction.

I am thinking now about just donating it so I don't have to deal with it.

I might go out and see where that leak is really coming from and patching it. Then I could drive it to get a price to have it fixed.

Since the pickup just sits all the time I do not really need it so I can live without it.

License plates and Insurance cost about \$500 a year. And I haven't put gas in it since October. Really, not since October 2009!

I use it to hold up the windmill tower. Another reason to get it moved to the antenna tower.

I will give Marie the car tomorrow instead of the pickup.

I might patch the leak and use the pickup or just put air in the tires on the bicycle and use it.

I guess I really should go see where that leak really is before I give in.

### Keep or Donate My Truck

The retail value of this pickup is about \$800 if it was in good condition. I would call it fair condition and it had over 130,000 mile on it. In fair condition I might get \$500.00 if I spent a couple hundred dollars to make it run and be safe.

That would me I would have to pay \$200 to get \$500. This makes it only worth \$300.00 hard cash in my pocket after spending a little money to advertize it.

If I donate it will cost me nothing and I will be able to get a \$500.00 tax deduction. A \$500.00 tax deduction would save me about \$100.00 on my taxes.

That \$100 along with not needing license plates and pickup insurance will save me another \$500 makes \$600.00 I have in my pocket.

So I donate the pickup to Kars-4-Kids and I get 2 nigh 3 day stay in a hotel. Oh if you donate a car you get 2 nights stay in a hotel free. That must be worth \$150.00.

\$550.00 is one payment on the motor home.

Ok I think I will donate and walk until Marie is finished using my car.

I can get rid of a broken pickup and gain enough money to make payment on the motor home and get healthier because I am walking for few days.

You and Mom raised 7 of us kids. And we all turned out ok. Well the rest of them are ok.

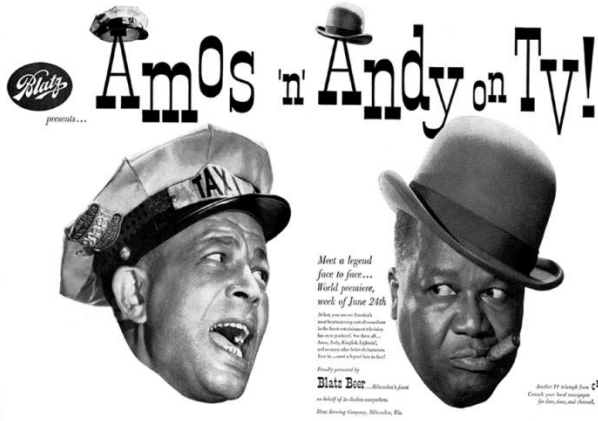

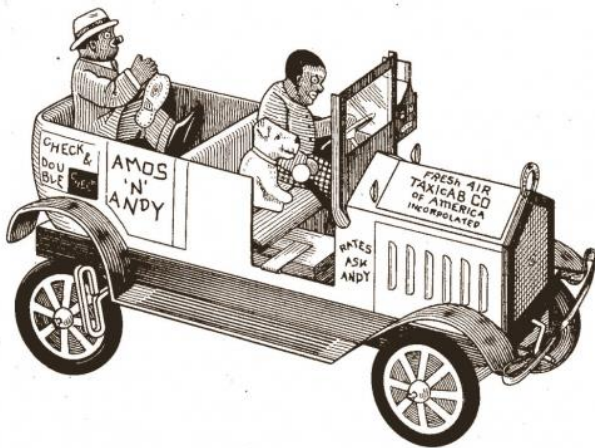
### Blatz Beer
